HOW TO REACH IT

Airport: Genoa's airport "Cristoforo Colombo" is at 7 Km, 15-minute taxi ride. Bus: 30 minutes with shuttle bus Volabus (stop De Ferrari). Metro De Ferrari Stop / S. Giorgio or 15-minute walk, direction Porto Antico.
